Today each child from Y1 to Y6 will bring home a questionnaire for you to complete and return to school. It contains 16 statements. 14 of these are the statements that ofsted use to judge schools from parental feedback, with the addition of a statement on church values and a statement on engaging parents, a current focus for the school.

Please tick the box which best suits your feeling on the statement and return to the box in the school office before Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November. **Please ensure you record which class your child is in.** 

There are ways that you can make your questionnaire even more useful to us as a school:

- Put your name so we can ask you for elaboration or clarification to further inform us of your views
- Where you strongly agree or disagree, write a brief comment on the reverse
- Make comments on the reverse if there is additional feedback you wish to give the school even if not covered by a questionnaire statement

Last year we only had 57% of questionnaires returned. The more we have returned the more accurate the picture of parental views is formed and the more we can strive to improve. To that end, when you return your questionnaire to the school office you will be able to take a raffle ticket. On Monday  $2^{nd}$  December we will have a draw and winning ticket numbers will be written in the newsletter on Wednesday  $4^{th}$  December. Parents with the winning tickets can then collect prizes from the school office.

As a school we value parental feedback. Findings from last year's questionnaire contributed significantly to the writing of the school improvement plan for this year.
