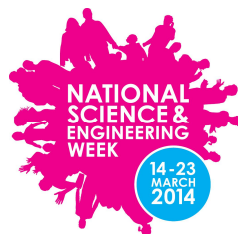

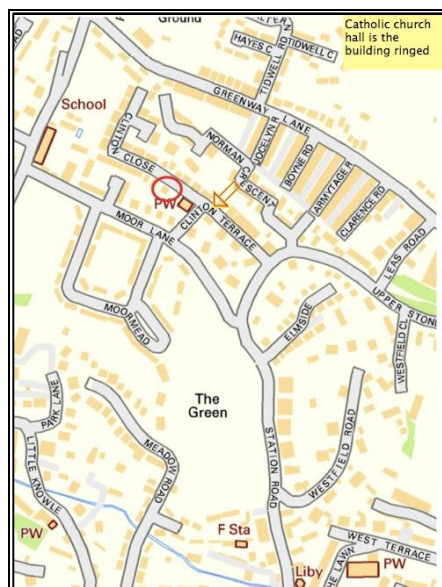
Budleigh Salterton Community Larder
