If you would like to take part you will need a bicycle in good working condition, a felmet which has been adjusted to fit, and a drink. If you have any concerns about the condition of your bicycle, please take it to a local bicycle maintenance shop before the event.

We recommend that pupils we ar clothing that is comfortable for cycling, taking into consideration the weather and any possible changes in it. Baggy clothing is not recommended for cycling, as it canget caught in moving parts. Ple ase bring a spare set of clothing because Cyclocross can sometime be muddy. Cycling gloves are recommended by British Cycling, but are not mandatory for this event.

A parent or guardian will have to sign a consent form for this event, copies of which will be available at the event. Please arrive early for Registration so that the race cancommence on time.
