#### Dear Parents/ Carers

Welcome back to a new term, the last in this school year. I hope that the Easter break has been a time of refreshment and that everyone is ready for another busy term. It was good to see many families at **the Easter exhibition** held in the hall during the last few days of March. Your kind comments were much appreciated. I should like to thank Mr Thomas and Mrs Jenkins for leading the event and for putting much time, effort and thought towards making it a memorable occasion.

**During the holidays**, new fences have been erected at the front and the rear of the school. The bins and an outside learning area have been fenced in tidying up the site and making it safer. Some outside walls have also been painted a neutral colour. Should new classrooms be built in the near future the far playground wall will be demolished to access the new buildings.

The first major event of this term is next week when the school will be holding a thanks-giving service at the church at 10am on Friday 26th April to mark the centenary of the opening of St Peter's school. I hope that many parents can join us for the service. Mayor Courtney Richards (past pupil) has kindly donated a centenary cup which will be presented at the service. May is an exceptionally busy month for the teachers. Pupil progress is formally assessed through-out this month. Year 6 sit the national tests in the week of the 13th May and other Key Stage 2 classes will do other national tests too as well as teacher assessments. In Year 2 the children have to be formally assessed to measure progress and this takes place over the entire month often in groups rather than as a class. Arrangements in Year 1 are similar to those at Year 2. Assessments and tests will be handled as sensitively as possible to mitigate any concerns and possible anxieties. As with all other local schools requests for additional holidays will not be authorised.

Following last year's notification from **OfSTED** I am reminding you that the school could be inspected any time, in the near future. Four and half years have elapsed since St Peter's was last inspected (December, 2008). The school will only be given short notice (the day before) of the inspection. Parents might like to share their views (hopefully constructive) about the school by using Parent view on the OfSTED website found here: **http://parentview.ofsted.gov.uk/** and registering to leave your comments as a formal meeting of inspectors with parents will not be possible.

Please note the dates 20th -24th May which is **walk to school week** which is being promoted by Devon and Cornwall Police. We also hope to run **sports day** on Tuesday 21st May with the 23<sup>rd</sup> Mayas being the reserved date.

#### Is your child entitled to Free School Meals?

Nursery aged children can receive Free School Meals if:-

- They attend an LA maintained nursery (not private)
- They attend before and after lunch sessions

Students attending sixth forms can receive Free School Meals if:-

• They attend tertiary education in a school **not** at a tertiary college

#### How do I apply?

Free School Meals are administered by Devon County Council (DCC) for all Devon maintained schools and you should apply to Devon if your child(ren) are attending a Devon school. The claimant in receipt of the qualifying benefit will need to apply:

- Phone 0845 155 1019 with your National Insurance Number, date of birth, name and child's details and an eligibility check can be carried out using the Department for Education's Eligibility Checking System, this will confirm if your details have been matched or not. It will not tell us what benefits you are in receipt of, dates when a benefit was awarded or say how much you receive
- Apply online by <u>downloading an application form</u> (862KB <u>pdf help</u>) and emailing it to the Free School Meals Team at <u>freeschoolmeals@devon.gov.uk</u>
- Once we have received your application, we will enter your details onto the **Department** for Education's Eligibility Checking System and it will tell us if you are entitled or not
- We will then inform your child's school and send you a letter with our decision, usually within 5-10 working days
- If it states **AUTHORI SED:** we will inform the school and your child will be able to receive Free School Meals
- If it states **NOT AUTHORISED**: we will inform the school and if you still believe you are entitled, please call **0845 155 1019** for advice. We may need you to send us evidence that you are in receipt of a qualifying benefit
- You no longer have to reapply as we are able to carry out an audit check from time to time on your eligibility status, however as soon as your circumstances change, for example you start to receive Working Tax Credits or you stop receiving any of the qualifying benefits above, you must notify DCC by phoning 0845 155 1019 and then we will inform your child(rens) school. We do not get automatically informed if your circumstances change and you no longer qualify for Free School Meals.

# When you apply, you won't need to provide us with any evidence of your benefit, we can check your eligibility status for you.
