

Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for all your support during the inspection days of last week, your kind words of encouragement meant a great deal to the staff and myself. Thank you also, to those parents who managed to go on to **Parent view** and express their views and opinions, it mirrored very closely the monitoring and evaluation work we had carried out earlier in the autumn term on parent perceptions. The inspectors told me that some parents had written special letters of support. The inspection went well and a full report will be available in about 2-3 weeks time.

Thank you also for those that came **to Friday's centenary service**. A personal gift was made of a centenary commemorative cup by Mayor Courtney Richards. Mr Richards attended St Peter's and so did his father (also a past mayor - 3 times) being part of the first cohort of pupils in April, 1913. I congratulate Milo Godwin-Coombs in Year 6 who very competently read the first lesson from the King James Bible and Finn McGlashan who read the second reading eloquently from a more recent version. We shall endeavour to arrange a centenary photograph of the whole school in June and parents will be able to purchase this keep-sake.

You can vote for this project on the Green on **Gala Saturday - 25th May** - we need all families, friends and neighbours to vote if we are to be successful. We are so fortunate to have **Warm Wish** whose hard work has paid off in dividends in Budleigh over recent years ensuring that our children are good swimmers and are safe in water. **The continued improvements to the pool have been wonderful.**

As you can see by last week's **lunch time numbers** that for the first time in a normal week the average uptake of meals was in excess of the target of 100 per day. This is a **milestone** for us and I congratulate the kitchen staff in achieving this target. Although it has taken a year to achieve, I hope we can now maintain and build on this number. **Thank you for your support and encouragement.**

Is your child entitled to Free School Meals?

Nursery aged children can receive Free School Meals if:-

- They attend an LA maintained nursery (not private)
- They attend before and after lunch sessions

How do I apply?

Free School Meals are administered by Devon County Council (DCC) for all Devon maintained schools and you should apply to Devon if your child(ren) are attending a Devon school. The claimant in receipt of the qualifying benefit will need to apply:

- Phone 0845 155 1019 with your National Insurance Number, date of birth, name and child's details and an eligibility check can be carried out using the Department for Education's Eligibility Checking System, this will confirm if your details have been matched or not. It will not tell us what benefits you are in receipt of, dates when a benefit was awarded or say how much you receive
- Apply online by <u>downloading an application form</u> (862KB <u>pdf help</u>) and emailing it to the Free School Meals Team at freeschoolmeals@devon.gov.uk

When you apply, you won't need to provide us with any evidence of your benefit, DCC can check your eliqibility status for you.
