School Census Thursday 16th January Additional funding to school for service children and adopted children

If either parent is in the **armed services** or if your child is **adopted** from care please make sure that the staff in the school office know. On 16^{th} January we have to complete a school census and this information needs to be included if the school is to receive the additional £300 Service Premium for each service child and £1,900 Pupil Premium for each adopted child.

The school receives Pupil Premium for all children who are entitled to **Free School Meals** (whether or not they have school dinners). If you think your children may be entitled and have not yet registered please do so as soon as possible.
